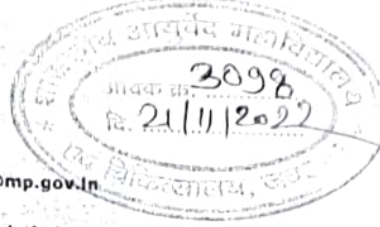

**Subject:-** Grant of conditional permission to Government Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwanghat, Jabalpur-482008, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID- AYU0123) for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 02.11.2022 -regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- This is with reference to the first appeal filed by the Commissioner, Directorate of AYUSH, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh vide letter ref. no. F-2022/4-स्थापना/5023-5026 dated 02.11.2022 to the commission in respect of denial of conditional permission issued to the Govt. Colleges of Madhya Pradesh for conducting UG and PG courses as the case may be due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder due to non availability of teaching, non-teaching staff, hospital staff and other shortcoming as mentioned in denial orders dated 18.10.2022 & 27.10.2022.
- Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee and provided an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to The Commissioner, Department of Ayush Govt. of Madhya Pradesh vide commission letter Ref. no. NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) dated 07.11.2022 to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on 09.11.2022 in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the denial orders dated 18.10.2022 & 27.10.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal was held virtually on 09.11.2022 at 04:00 PM and on behalf of all Government colleges of Madhya Pradesh, Dr. Prateek Hathe Lal, Secretary Ayush, Madhya Pradesh and Principal of 05 Govt. Colleges of Madhya Pradesh attended the hearing.
- The hearing committee sought clarification from the representatives of Madhya Pradesh Government regarding shortcomings mentioned in the denial orders dated 18.10.2022 & 27.10.2022 passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, which is as under:-

Ayurveda Colleges of MP, also agreed for the same and submit that they may provide the affidavit regarding all short comings of their colleges.</li> <li>Appellant requested to give all UG and PG seats to all the colleges of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh as they are going to fulfill all the vacancies and will comply all shortcomings within stipulated time.</li> <li>Committee received the submission of advertisement of MPPSC regarding the recruitment of different posts and assured that all the unfilled posts may be recruited within schedule time along with affidavit as per attachment regarding permission for five Government Autonomous Ayurveda colleges, (i.e Govt. Auto Ayurveda College Jabalpur, Govt. Auto Ayurveda College Rewa, Govt Auto Ayurveda College Gwalior, Govt. Auto. Ayurveda college Burahanpur and Govt. Auto Ayurveda College, Ujjain) for the academic session 2022-23. For the Academic session 2022-23.</li> </ul>
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- The submission made by the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh was placed before the designated hearing committee and hearing committee sought clarification regarding the shortcomings mentioned in the denial orders dated 18.10.22 & 27.10.22 and also asked for the compliance of Shortcomings and asked the representatives to submit the affidavit regarding their assurance in respect of fulfillment of all requisite of the staff/Faculty in respect of their appeal.
- In response of the same, **Sh. Pankaj Sharma, Deputy Secretary, Ayush Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh vide letter no. 3883/2022/1/59 dated 09.11.2022 submitted the affidavit dated 08.11.2022** with the affirmation to fulfill all shortcomings with regards to Non-Availability of Teaching, Non-Teaching, Hospital staff and other shortcomings as mentioned.
- Hence, in view of the affidavit dated 08.11.2022 submitted by the Deputy Secretary, Ayush Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh vide **letter no. 3883/2022/1/59 dated 09.11.2022**, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide **letter no. NCISM/Comm./Appeal/(2022-23) dated 15.11.2022** to grant conditional permission to **Government Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwarighat, Jabalpur-482008, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID- AYU0123)** under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23.
- Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to issue conditional permission to **Government Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwarighat, Jabalpur-482008, Madhya Pradesh (Inst. ID- AYU0123)** for intake capacity with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 on the basis of affidavit dated 08.11.2022 submitted vide letter no. 3883/2022/1/59 dated 09.11.2022 by the Deputy Secretary, Ayush Department, Government of Madhya Pradesh subject to following condition:-
  - It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2022-23 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
- Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.

10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2022 and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2023-24:
- all the requirements of Minimum Standard of Infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
  - all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
  - all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in to; and
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission from the academic session 2023-24.
