Subject:- Grant of conditional permission to Govt. Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwarighat, Jabalpur-482008, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst. ID-AYU0123) with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

- With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.
 - 1. It is pertinent to mention here that conditional permission to take admission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the Academic Year 2022-23 was issued to you on the basis of affidavit dated 08.11.2022 submitted by the Deputy Secretary, AYUSH Dept, Govt. of Madhya Pradesh vide letter no. 3883/2022/1/59 dated 09.11.2022 at the time of first appeal filed by you to the Commission, NCISM for issuance of conditional permission for the academic year 2022-2023.
 - Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Govt. Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwarighat, Jabalpur-482008, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst. ID-AYU0123) inspection of your College was conducted on 11.05.2023 & 12.05.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
- 3. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

Teaching staffs:-

a) Availability of total teaching staff for UG after considering all the teachers mentioned by the visitor is $\frac{Available}{Required} x 100\% = \frac{24}{30} x 100\% = 80\%$ (Excluding Excess).

 In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the 41st Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 29.05.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 30.05.2020 to appear on 01.06.2023 before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause at to why not the conditional permission to your college with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24.

5. The college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide ref. 2023/2857-59 date 31.05.2023 against the deficiencies conveyed to them. Whereas, the college through its representatives, Dr. L.L. Ahirwal, Principal and Faculty of Rog Nidan appeared before the Hearing Committee on 01.06.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

6. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 an relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the 42nd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 07.06.2023.

7. Whereas, in view of the shortcoming and deficiencies mentioned in above paras, and as per the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and it is found that the college is not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020. However, Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved special policy to be adopted for Government colleges of Madhya Pradesh for issuance of permission only for the Academic Year 2023-24 as under:-

In case of UG Course:- Those teaching faculties who are working as Lecturers or Assistant Professor but have more than 5 years of experience or working as Readers or Associate Professors but have more than 10 years of experience will be considered in place of Associate Professor or Professor as ever the case may be. But teaching faculties who are considered as above are not entitled for higher cadre experience.

Accordingly, in the **department of Swasthvritta and Yoga**, college is having 02 eligible teaching faculty (02 Assistant Professor) and both of them have more than 5 years of teaching experience but working as Assistant Professors, therefore, as per the above approved special policy, 01 Assistant Professor with more than 5 years of experience can be considered in place of Associate Professor, and no shortcoming persists in the department of Swasthvritta and Yoga.

Accordingly, in the **department of Prasuti and Stri Roga**, college is having 03 eligible teaching faculty (03 Assistant Professor) and two of them have more than 5 years of teaching experience but working as Assistant Professors, therefore, as per the above approved special policy, 02 Assistant Professors with more than 5 years of experience can be considered in place of Associate Professor, and no shortcoming persists in the department of Prasuti and Stri Roga.

Accordingly, in the **department of Kaumarbhritya**, college is having 02 eligible teaching faculty (02 Assistant Professor) and both of them have more than 5 years of teaching experience but working as Assistant Professors, therefore, as per the above approved special policy, 01 Assistant Professor with more than 5 years of experience can be considered in place of Associate Professor, and no shortcoming persists in the department of Kaumarbhritya.

Accordingly as per Schedule-V Note (iii) of MSR 2016 the deficiency of teacher for up to sixty intake capacity shall not exceed more than ten percent of total requirement. And after applying the special policy, college is having 27 total eligible teaching faculties excluding excess staff. And availability of total teaching staff is 90% and fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.

- 8. Therefore, in view of above, Conditional Permission is granted to Govt. Autonomous Ayurved College, Gwarighat, Jabaipur-482008, Madhya Pradesh, (Inst. ID-AYU0123) with 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under for the academic session 2023-24.
 - (i) It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- 8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
 - (i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;

(ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education)

Regulations 2016

(iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);

- (iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations rmade, thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
- 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25:
